

HISTOPATHOLOGY REPORT: EXAMPLE REPORT

CLINICAL NOTES:

Bx histopath antrum Clo. See figure below.

MACROSCOPY:

Antral Bx: The specimen consists of one tan portion of tissue measuring 4mm in largest dimension. All in, 1 Block. An AB-PAS and HP are ordered for this specimen. A CLO test is also received. (SC/sa)

MICROSCOPY:

The sections show antral type gastric mucosal fragment. The fovea-glandular architecture is preserved. There is a chronic inflammatory cell infiltrate in the lamina propria consisting of lymphocytes and plasma cells. There is no active inflammation. There are no Helicobacter-like organisms seen on routine or on immunohistochemical stains. There is no intestinal metaplasia seen. There is no evidence of dysplasia or malignancy.


